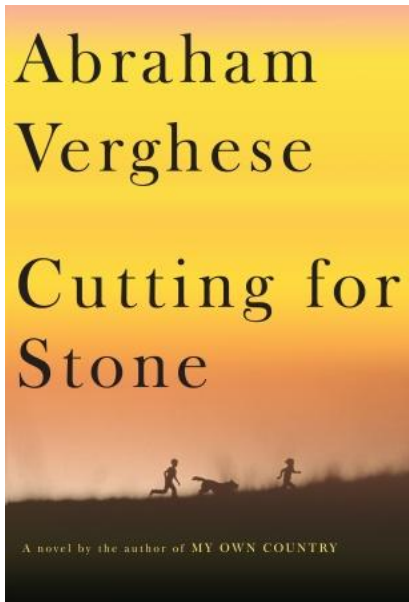


BOOK GROUP

The selection is *Cutting for Stone* by Abraham Verghese. Marion and Shiva Stone are twin brothers born of a secret union between a beautiful Indian nun and a brash British surgeon. Orphaned by their mother's death and father's disappearance, the twins come of age as Ethiopia hovers on the brink of revolution. Moving from Addis Ababa to New York City and back again, this novel is a story of love and betrayal, medicine and ordinary miracles—and two brothers whose fates are forever intertwined.

Need some summer reading? We are considering these for future selections:

- *The Other Wes Moore: One Name, Two Fates* by Wesley Moore. This was the 2011 Everybody Reads selection, so copies are readily available. This nonfiction work explores the journey of two boys who grew up on a Baltimore ghetto: one becomes a Rhodes scholar, the other goes to prison for killing a police officer.
- *Bonhoeffer: Pastor, Martyr, Prophet, Spy* by Eric Metaxas. The new biography of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, the Lutheran pastor and seminary professor who spoke out against the Nazis, comes highly recommended by members. It is 600 pages and well worth the read. Paperback is slated to come out in August.
